In 1968, student and worker protested against rising unemployment and poverty under a conservative government. In May 1968, students and faculty at the L'école des Beaux-Arts took over the lithography studio and established the Atelier Populaire (the Popular Workshop). This was originally designed by the Atelier Populaire, and was reworked and updated for a 21st century context.
